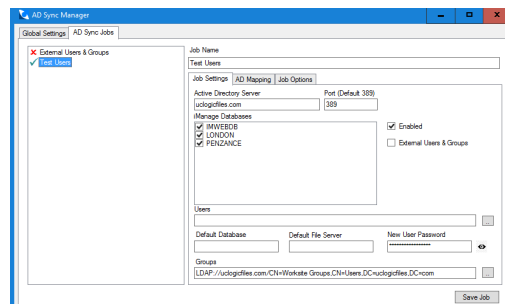


Take control of the user and group synchronization process

The standard iManage user and group synchronisation process forces you to import complete containers from Active Directory, often leading to the unnecessary creation of service accounts, dummy accounts and unwanted groups in your iManage databases. You could re-arrange your Active Directory, but it's far easier to use UC Logic AD Sync to import only the users and groups you need.

Key Features

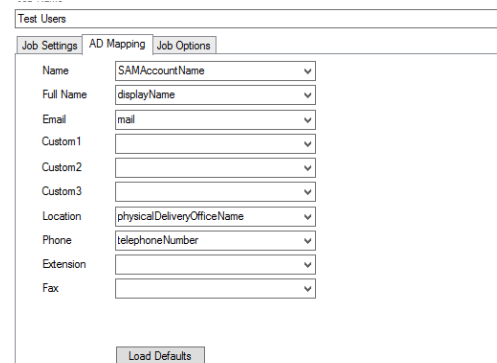
- Use Active Directory groups to control the process

Requirements

- On Premises iManage 10 server
- iManage 10 Desktop client

AD Sync allows you to use Active Directory groups to select which users and groups should be synchronised with which iManage databases, so a whole container does not need to be synchronised.

Customise the Active Directory fields to be imported.
